

Driving Directions

Sunday River is located 90 minutes from Portland, ME, and 3 hours from Boston, MA.

Bethel, ME

Follow Rt. 2 East for 2.6 miles. Take a left onto Sunday River Road, marked by the large Sunday River Brewery (big building with red roof). Follow Sunday River Road to a fork with a "Sunday River Ski Resort" sign. Fork left and follow signs for the Grand Summit Hotel, base lodges, and amenities (1 mile). Fork right and follow signs for the Jordan Grand Resort Hotel (5 miles).

Boston Logan International Airport

Take Route 60 North to Route 1 North to I-95 North and follow directions above.

Portland Jetport / Portland, ME

Exit the Jetport and follow signs to I-95, the Main Turnpike. Take I-95 North to Exit 63 / Gray for Route 26. Take Route 26 North to Bethel. Refer to Bethel directions above.

Bangor, ME

Take I-95 South to Exit 157/ Newport for Route 2. Follow Route 2 West to Sunday River Road, marked by the large Sunday River Brewery (big building with red roof), a few miles before reaching Bethel. Follow directions above.

Manchester, NH

Take I-93 North to Exit 35 / Twin Mountain for Route 3. Take Route 3 North to Route 115 North. At the end of Route 115, go right on Route 2 East all the way to Bethel. Refer to Bethel directions above.

North Conway, NH

Take Route 16 North to the intersection with Route 2 in Gorham, NH. Take Route 2 East all the way to Bethel. Refer to Bethel directions above.

Fort Kent, ME

From East Main Street, head south on Route 11. Turn right on I-95. Take I-95 to Bangor. Refer to Bangor directions above.

Portsmouth, NH

Take I-95 North into Maine. Follow I-95 / Maine Turnpike to Exit 63 / Gray for Route 26. Take Route 26 North to Bethel. Refer to Bethel directions above.

Concord, NH

Take I-93 North to Exit 35 / Twin Mountain for Route 3. Take Route 3 North to Route 115 North. At the end of Route 115, go right on Route 2 East all the way to Bethel. Refer to Bethel directions above.

Boston, MA

Take I-95 North into Maine. Follow I-95 / Maine Turnpike to Exit 63 / Gray for Route 26. Take Route 26 North to Bethel. Refer to Bethel directions above.

Providence, RI

Take I-95 North into Maine. Follow I-95 / Maine Turnpike to Exit 63 / Gray for Route 26. Take Route 26 North to Bethel. Refer to Bethel directions above.

New York City

Take I-84 East to the Mass Pike / I-90. Take Mass Pike / I-90 East to Exit 10 / Auburn. Take I-290 East to I-495 North, then follow I-495 to I-95. Take I-95 North into Maine. Follow I-95 / Maine Turnpike to Exit 63 / Gray for Route 26. Take Route 26 North to Bethel. Refer to Bethel directions above.

Airlines / Airports

Logan Airport (BOS)

Logan Airport is located in Boston, Massachusetts. Most major domestic and international airlines fly to BOS. Visit the Airport's web site for a complete list of airlines.

Portland International Jetport (PWM)

The Portland International Jetport is one of New England's fastest growing airports serving Maine and northern New Hampshire. The airport offers nonstop flights to over a dozen cities across the U.S. and Canada as well as worldwide connections.

Public/Private Transportation

Sunday River Transportation (Contact your sales rep for details)

Sunday River owns and operates a fleet of buses that may be rented for group transportation. The current rental rate is \$100 per shuttle, per hour, with a minimum of 2 hours. When traveling outside of the Newry/Bethel area a fuel charge may be incurred. Fuel charges are based on that day's fuel cost at 10 miles per gallon (ex: \$4.00 per gallon = \$.40 per mile). Fuel charges will be confirmed by transportation. Wait time is billed at \$25 per hour.

Concord Coach Lines (Phone: 800-639-3317; www.concordcoachlines.com)

Concord Coach Lines provides transportation from Logan Airport in Boston to the Portland Transportation Center in Portland, Maine. Schedules and fares can be found on their web page. Additional car or shuttle service is required from the Maine Transportation Center to Sunday River (a 90-minute trip).

Amtrak Downeaster (Phone: 800-872-7245; www.amtrakdowneaster.com)

Amtrak provides train service from Boston, MA - North Station to Portland, ME. The journey is approximately 2.5 hours and costs around \$25. Additional car or shuttle service is required from the Portland Transportation Center to Sunday River (a 90-minute trip).

Stagecoach Shuttle Service provides convenient and affordable transportation for individuals and small groups from the Portland Transportation Center, Portland Jetport, Boston or Manchester. They will provide a friendly and knowledgeable professional driver to meet you and provide safe transportation to Sunday River. Reservations are recommended at least 2 weeks in advance.
